### **THE GIFTS CATEGORIZED**

1 Cor 12:4-6 (KJV)

4 Now there are **diversities of gifts (Spiritual Gifts)** but the same Spirit.

5 And there are **differences of administrations (Governmental Gifts)** but the same Lord

6 And there are **diversities of operations (Motivational Gifts)** but it is the same God which worketh all in all.

### **THE PURPOSE OF THE GIFTS**

1 Cor 12:7 (KJV)

7 But the manifestation of the Spirit is given to every man to profit withal.

## **THE 9 SPIRITUAL GIFTS**

1 Cor 12:8-11 (KJV)

8 For to one is given by the Spirit the **word of wisdom**; to another the **word of knowledge** by the same Spirit; 9 To another **faith** by the same Spirit; to another the **gifts of healing** by the same Spirit; 10 To another **the working of miracles**; to another **prophecy**; to another **discerning of spirits**; to another **divers kinds of tongues**; to another **the interpretation of tongues**: 11 But all these worketh that one and the selfsame Spirit, dividing to every man severally as he will.

### REVELATIONAL GIFTS (Those that reveal something)

**1. Wisdom, Word of** – The ability to know the mind of the Holy Spirit in such a way as to receive insight into how a word of knowledge may best be expressed and applied so that it cannot be refuted.

Acts 6: 3, 10 | I Corinthians 2: 6-13 | I Corinthians 12:8

**2. Knowledge, Word of** - The ability to know the mind of the Holy Spirit in such a way as to receive insight and information about a person that you could not have received through natural means. It is also information downloaded in the Spirit that was not learned through natural means.

Acts 5: 1-11 | I Corinthians 12:8 | Colossians 2:2-3

**3. Discernment of Spirits** - The ability to know with assurance whether certain people, their behavior or words spoken are of divine, human or satanic origin and motivation.

Matthew 16:21-23 | Acts 5:1-11 | Acts 16:16-18 | I Corinthians 12:10 | I John 4:1-6

### POWER GIFTS (Those that do something)

**4. Faith** - The ability to spiritually see the unseen and discern the will and purposes of God, then believe and act upon them with extraordinary confidence.

Acts 11:22-24 | Romans 4:18-21 | I Corinthians 12:9 | Hebrews 11

**5. Healing** - The ability to serve as human intermediaries through whom it pleases God to cure illness and restore health (both mental and physical) apart from the use of natural means.

Acts 3:1-10 | Acts 9:32-35 | Acts 28:7-10 | I Corinthians 12:9, 28

**6. Miracles** - The ability to serve as a human intermediary through whom it pleases God to perform powerful acts that is perceived by observers to have altered the ordinary course of nature in circumstances or lives. True miracles always undoubtedly cause both believers and unbelievers to give the glory to God by admitting that only He could have done it and become aware that no human or other god could have performed so perfectly.

UTTERANCE GIFTS  
(Those that say something)

**7. Prophecy Gift** – The ability to boldly communicate God’s rhema Word under divine anointing to people for their edification, exhortation and comfort.

1 Corinthians 12:10 | I Corinthians 14:1-4 | I Thessalonians 1:5

**8. Tongues** - The ability a.) to speak to God in a language they have never learned which may not be understood by oneself or others but only by those God intended to hear in their own language. b.) to receive and communicate an immediate message by God to His people through a divinely anointed utterance in a language they have never learned. c.) to speak in “groanings” through the Spirit of God, who intercedes for one’s own edification.

**9. Interpretation** - The ability to interpret tongues in the form of a revelation, knowledge, prophecy or doctrine.

### **THE 7 MOTIVATIONAL GIFTS**

Romans 12:3-8 (KJV)

3 For I say, through the grace given unto me, to every man that is among you, not to think of himself more highly than he ought to think; but to think soberly, according as God hath dealt to every man the measure of faith.

4 For as we have many members in one body, and all members have not the same office:

5 So we, being many, are one body in Christ, and every one members one of another.

6 Having then gifts differing according to the grace that is given to us, whether **prophecy**, let us prophesy according to the proportion of faith;

7 Or **ministry (service)**, let us wait on our ministering: or he that **teacheth**, on teaching;

8 Or he that **exhorteth (encouragement)**, on exhortation: he that **giveth**, let him do it with simplicity; he that **ruleth (leadership)**, with diligence; he that sheweth **mercy**, with cheerfulness.

**10. Prophecy Motivation**- The motivation to reveal unrighteous motives, actions, false concepts and erroneous traditions by presenting God’s truth in order to bring correction.

Romans 12:3-8 | Acts 2:37-40 | Acts 7:51-53

**11. Serving (Ministry)** - The motivation to demonstrate love by quickly identifying and meeting the practical needs of others.

Acts 6:1-7 | Romans 12:7 | Galatians 6:10 | II Timothy 1:16-18 | Titus 3:14

**12. Teaching** - The motivation to search out and effectively validate truth, which has been presented.

Acts 20:21 | Romans 12:7

**13. Exhortation (Encouragement)** - The motivation to give hope and stimulate the faith of others through words that challenge or rebuke in an encouraging manner.

Acts 14:22 | Romans 12:8 | I Timothy 4:13 | Hebrews 10:24-25

**14. Giving** - The motivation to entrust substantial personal assets to others for the furtherance of their ministry. Those with this gift understand that they are stewards and not possessors of their wealth.

Mark 12:41-44 | Romans 12:8 | II Corinthians 8:1-7 | II Corinthians 9:2-7

**15. Leadership (Ruling)** - The motivation to instill vision, coordinate and influence the activities of others for the achievement of a stated mission, purpose or plan.

Romans 12:8 | I Timothy 3: 1-13 | I Timothy 5:17 | Hebrews 13:17

**16. Mercy** - The motivation to feel sincere empathy and compassion in a way that results in practical relief for people’s hurts, pain and suffering.

Matthew 9:35, 36 | Mark 9:41 | Romans 12:8 | I Thessalonians 5:14

## **THE 5 GOVERNMENTAL GIFTS**

Eph 4:7-12 (KJV)

7 But unto every one of us is given grace according to the measure of the gift of Christ.

...

11 And he gave some, **apostles**; and some, **prophets**; and some, **evangelists**; and some, **pastors** and **teachers**;

12 For the perfecting of the saints, for the work of the ministry, for the edifying of the body of Christ:

**17. Apostle** – One given a measure of rule over specific spheres of regions and/or people groups in order to expand the government and kingdom of God; called directly by God and sent by the Holy Spirit to father and raise up leaders; with extraordinary spiritual authority in religious, business and political matters.  
Acts 15:22-35 | I Corinthians 12:28 | II Corinthians 12:12 | Galatians 2:7-10 | Ephesians 4:11-14

**18. Prophet** – One who is sent to speak for God with a current and divinely anointed message in specific detail for the current times and proven by the coming to pass of predicted events.  
Acts 2:37-40 | Acts 7:51-53

**19. Evangelist** – Has the ability to share the gospel with believers and unbelievers in such a way that motivates sinners to receive Jesus and saints to grow deeper in Christ.  
Acts 8:5-6 | Acts 8:26-40 | Acts 14:21 | Acts 21:8 | Ephesians 4:11-14

**20. Pastor** – A caregiver who assumes the long term personal responsibility for the spiritual welfare of a group of believers.  
John 10:1-18 | Ephesians 4:11-14 | I Timothy 3:1-7 | I Peter 5:1-3

**21. Teacher** – One who has the ability systematically and logically communicate deep revelation out of the Word of God in a clear and simple way.  
Ephesians 4:11-13 | I Corinthians 12:28 | Acts 18:24-28

## **THE PURPOSE OF THE GOVERNMENT**

Eph 4:13 (KJV)

13 Till we all come in the unity of the faith, and of the knowledge of the Son of God, unto a perfect man, unto the measure of the stature of the fullness of Christ:

## **THE 7 SPECIAL GIFTS**

**22. Administration (Governments)** – The gift of administration is the ability to create and maintain systems that coordinate and organize people and projects.

Luke 14:28-30 | Acts 6:1-7 | I Corinthians 12:10

**23. Celibacy**- The gift of celibacy is the special ability that God gives to certain members of the Body of Christ to remain single and enjoy it; to be unmarried and not suffer undue sexual temptations.

1 Cor. 7:7

**24. Poverty, Voluntary** - The gift of voluntary poverty is the special ability that God gives to certain members of the Body of Christ to renounce marital comfort and luxury and adopt a personal lifestyle equivalent to those living at the poverty level in a given society in order to serve God more effectively.

**26. Missionary**- The gift of missionary is the special ability that God gives to certain members of the Body of Christ to minister whatever other spiritual gifts they have in a second culture.

**27. Deliverance** - (Exorcism) The gift of deliverance is the special ability that God gives to certain members of the Body of Christ to see, hear and/or cast out demons and evil spirits.

**28. Samson**- The gift of Samson is a gift that God gives certain believers in times of life and death situations or great adversity.

## **THE 6 SUPPORTING GIFTS**

**29. Intercession** - The gift of intercession is the special ability that God gives to certain members of the Body of Christ to pray for extended periods of time on a regular basis and see frequent and specific answers to their prayers to a degree much greater than that which is expected of the average Christian.

**30. Helps** – The gift of helps is the ability to work, with high-level authority, directly under and support those in leadership positions with specialized skills in a way that advances the kingdom of God greatly.
